FS1 We have had another fabulous week in Nursery. This week in literacy we have been learning all about Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The children have come up with some fantastic actions to help us remember the story. In maths we have been learning all about 3D shapes. The children have used their knowledge of shapes to identify everyday objects that are the same shape. Well done, Nursery.

Y1

Year 1 have had a busy and exciting week. We have been planning our own version of the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' using the story map and story mountain. We read the story and found that something dreadful had happened to the wolf. In maths, we have been subtracting numbers in different ways to find the answer. We had great fun hunting for deciduous and evergreen trees and created a sketch of the trees we found and took a bark rubbing.

Y2 We have fitted a lot into this week in year two! In writing, we have planned our own defeating the monster stories, ready to write them next week. In maths, we have completed our multiplication work by investigating the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. In art we have started to learn how to weave and in science we have designed our own investigations to explore why it is so important to wash our hands. We have had an exciting week learning about the 3 types of Matter—solids, liquids and gas.

Y5/6B

In 5/6B this week, the children in year 6 have completed their bikeability training and they have all enjoyed being out on their bikes! In writing, we have completed our tale of suspense with the children producing some hair-raising moments in their writing! In maths, we have moved on to algebra - the children have learned how to use function machines and have used substitution. At the beginning of the week, we looked at The Charge of the Light Brigade and the class absolutely loved the poem. We ended up doing some research into the Crimean War as a result. We have also moved on to looking at electricity in science and used books as sources to research opinions on World War 2.

FS2H This week we have started reading The Magic Porridge Pot, to kick start our learning we made and tasted porridge! We have created some actions to go alongside our story map and have recapped our learning on maps, creating a map to show the journey in the story. We then went on a short walk around school and drew the map of this when we got back. We have been comparing mass in Mathematics, using our weighing scales to help. We have also enjoyed creating some winter crafts!

FS2C We've had a very busy week in FS2C! We have started to read our brand new story The Magic Porridge Pot and even got to make some porridge on Monday. We have also been looking at maps and made our very own map of the school grounds. In PE, we all worked really hard and did lots of throwing, catching and kicking in groups.

Y3 Year 3 have had a great week this week. In maths, we have been multiplying two digits by one digit and in reading we have all taken on the role of a rapper and performed it to our class! In writing we have started writing our own instructions on how to tame an animal and in forest schools we were on a hunt for worms and counting the number of birds for the RSPB.
